 - Special requests can be more easily accommodated when they are received early.

Requesting Pariticpants:

- Start early to schedule your college visitors (remember, your request must be received one month prior to their visit)
- Send clear directions to your church
- Send a sample bulletin and mark where they will participate
- Provide relevant information about the service: time, level of formality, etc.
- No payment is expected—the intent is to provide an opportunity for contact between church college.
- Mileage reimbursement is expected at the federal rate (currently 48.5 cents per mile).

Welcoming Your Visitors:

Before the Service:

- Ask someone from the congregation to greet them and help them feel comfortable and welcome.
- Review the order of service and the operation of the sound system with them.
- Introduce them to several members.
- Show them where they will sit and when they will participate.
- Show them the restrooms and the water fountain.

After the Service:

- Invite the participants to join the greeting line after the service.
- Consider providing an opportunity for light refreshments and socializing.
- Provide lunch at the church or a member's home.
- Have a member take them to a local restaurant.
- Provide funds for them to have lunch on the return trip to campus.

(Note: if possible, make lunch arrangements with participants prior to their visit.)
