CHRISTIAN AND PAGAN: Food Offered to Idols I Cor. 8:1-13

1. Now concerning food offered to idols: KNOWLEDGE, GOD we know that, "all of us have knowledge." AND LOVE "Knowledge" puffs up but love builds up. If any one imagines that he knows something, 2. he does not yet know as he ought to know. But if one loves God, one is known by him. 3. Hence, as to the food offered to idols, KNOWLEDGE, GOD we know that "an idol has no real existence," AND IDOLS and that "there is no God but one." For although there may be so called gods in heaven or on earth as indeed there are many 'gods' and many 'lords,' -NO IDOLS yet for us there is one God, the Father, 4. from whom are all things and for whom we exist, and one Lord, Jesus Christ, ONE GOD through whom are all things ONE LORD and through whom we exist. However, not all possess this knowledge. 5. KNOWLEDGE, GOD But some, through being hitherto accustomed to idols, AND THE WEAK eat food as really offered to an idol; WEAK CONSCIENCE and their conscience, being weak, is defiled. **BROTHER DEFILED** 6. Food will not commend us to God. We are no worse off if we do not eat. EAT/ NOT EAT and no better off if we do. FREEDOM AND Only take care lest this liberty of yours RESPONSIBILITY becomes a stumbling-block to the weak. 7. For if any one sees you, a man of knowledge, reclining in an idol's temple, WEAK CONSCIENCE if his conscience is weak, **BROTHER WOR. IDOLS** might he not be encouraged to eat food offered to idols? 8. And so by your knowledge KNOWLEDGE, CHRIST this weak man is destroyed, AND YOUR BROTHER the brother for whom Christ died. YOUR BROTHER DESTROYED 9. Thus, sinning against your brethren and wounding their conscience when it is weak, SIN AGAINST you sin against Christ. **CHRIST** 10. Therefore, if food is a cause of my brother's stumbling, YOUR BROTHER STUMBLES

I will never eat meat,

lest I cause my brother to stumble.
