MEN AND WOMEN PROPERTS

I Cor. 11:2-16

THE TRADITION 1. I commend you because you remember me in everything and maintain the traditions as I have delivered them to you. 2. Now (de) I want you to understand that A THEOLOGICAL the *head* (origin) of every *man is Christ*, PRINCIPLE the *head* (origin) of women is man, the *head* (origin) of *Christ is God*. _____ 3. Any man who prays or prophesies CHURCH PRACTICE with his *head covered* (and its reason) dishonors his head. any woman who prays or prophesies with her *head unveiled* dishonors her head -4. **EXAMPLE - WOMEN** for it is the same as if her head were *shaved*. for if a woman (prophet) will not veil herself, (shaved = dishonor/disgrace) then let her cut off her hair; But if it is disgraceful for a woman to be shorn or shaved then let her wear a veil. 5. For a *man* ought *not* to *cover the head*. MEN - NOT COVER since he is the *image* and *glory of God*; Gen. 1:27 and woman is the glory of man. 6. For man is not from (ek) woman, MAN - NOT FROM WOMAN but (alla) woman is from (ek) man. WOMAN FROM MAN 7 For man was not created because of (dia) woman, DEPENDENCE but woman because of (dia) the man. Gen. 2:18 8. Because of (dia) this the woman should have authority on the head, **AUTHORITY** because of (dia) the angels. 9. Specifically (plen), woman is not independent of man nor man independent of woman in the Lord: **DEPENDENCE** 10. for as the woman is from (ek) the man, WOMAN FROM MAN so also the man is (born) through (dia) the woman. MAN THROUGH WOMAN And all things are from (ek) God. Gen. 1:27 **WOMEN - VEILED** 11. Judge in yourselves: is it proper for a woman to pray to God unveiled? 12. Does not *nature* itself teach you **EXAMPLE - MEN** that for a man to wear long hair (long hair = dishonor)it is *dishonor* to him, **EXAMPLE - WOMEN** but if a woman has long hair, (long hair = glory)it is her *glorv*? For her hair is given to her for a covering.

13. If anyone is disposed to be contentious we recognize *no other* practice, nor do the *churches of God*.

CHURCH PRACTICE

ORDER IN WORSHIP: The Lord's Supper I Cor. 11:17-34

1. But in the following instructions I do not praise you, because it is *not* for the *better* WHEN YOU MEET but for the worse you assemble. IT IS FOR THE WORSE -----2. For, in the first place, **UNWORTHY MANNER:** when you assemble as a *church*, **DIVISIONS** I hear that there are divisions among you; HUNGER and I partly believe it, **DRUNKENNESS** for there must be quarreling among you in order that those who are genuine among you may be recognized. Therefore when you assemble it is not the Lord's supper that you eat. For in eating, each one goes ahead with his own meal, and one is hungry and another is drunk. What! Do you not have houses to eat and drink in? Or do you despise the church of God YOU DESPISE 4. and humiliate those who have nothing? THE CHURCH 5. What shall I say to you? Shall I praise you in this? I will not praise you. **JUDGMENT** For I received from the Lord 6. what I also delivered to you, "he Lord Jesus on the night when he was betrayed, took bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it, and said, 'This is my body which is for you. TRADITION FROM Do this in remembrance of me.' THE LORD In the same way also the cup after supper saying, 'This cup is the new covenant in my blood. Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me.' For as often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he come." 7. Whoever, therefore, eats the bread UNWORTHY MANNER or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner PROFANING BODY/BLOOD will be guilty of profaning the body and blood of the Lord. Let a man examine himself, and so eat of the bread and drink of the cup. 8. For any one who eats and drinks DISCERN without discerning the body THE BODY 9. eats and drinks judgment upon himself. That is why many of you are weak and ill, and some have died. But if we judge ourselves, **JUDGMENT** we should not be judged. But when we are *judged* by the Lord, we are chastened so that we may not be *judged* along with the world. 10. So then, my brethren, when you come together to eat, wait for one another -WHEN YOU MEET: if anyone is hungry, let him eat at home -LEST - CONDEMNED lest you come together to be condemned. 11.
