Important Considerations:

- God does mission, but he has invited us to be his partner! Mission is not about us, it is about Jesus. We must remember to pray and dwell in scripture!!!!
- Christ is calling us to be his witnesses and show his love to all people. Acts 1:8 But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem (local community), in all Judea (beyond our boundaries) and Samaria (outside of our comfort zone), and to the ends of the earth.
- Jesus died to redeem individuals not programs, so we need to build relationships.
- Mission is just not done by a committee. Mission is not a program, but the very being of the church so we need to involve the entire congregation.

Questions to Ask:

- How is God working all around us?
- How can we join God?
- Are we willing to step outside our comfort zone and be a part of what God is doing?
