Dear Sisters and Brothers of Shenango Presbytery,

I will always be interested in hearing about what is happening in Shenango Presbytery, but I will not be commenting on it and I will most definitely not be commenting on the work of my successor. I certainly will be praying daily for him/her and all of you. God is definitely able to sustain the churches of Shenango Presbytery without help from me!
